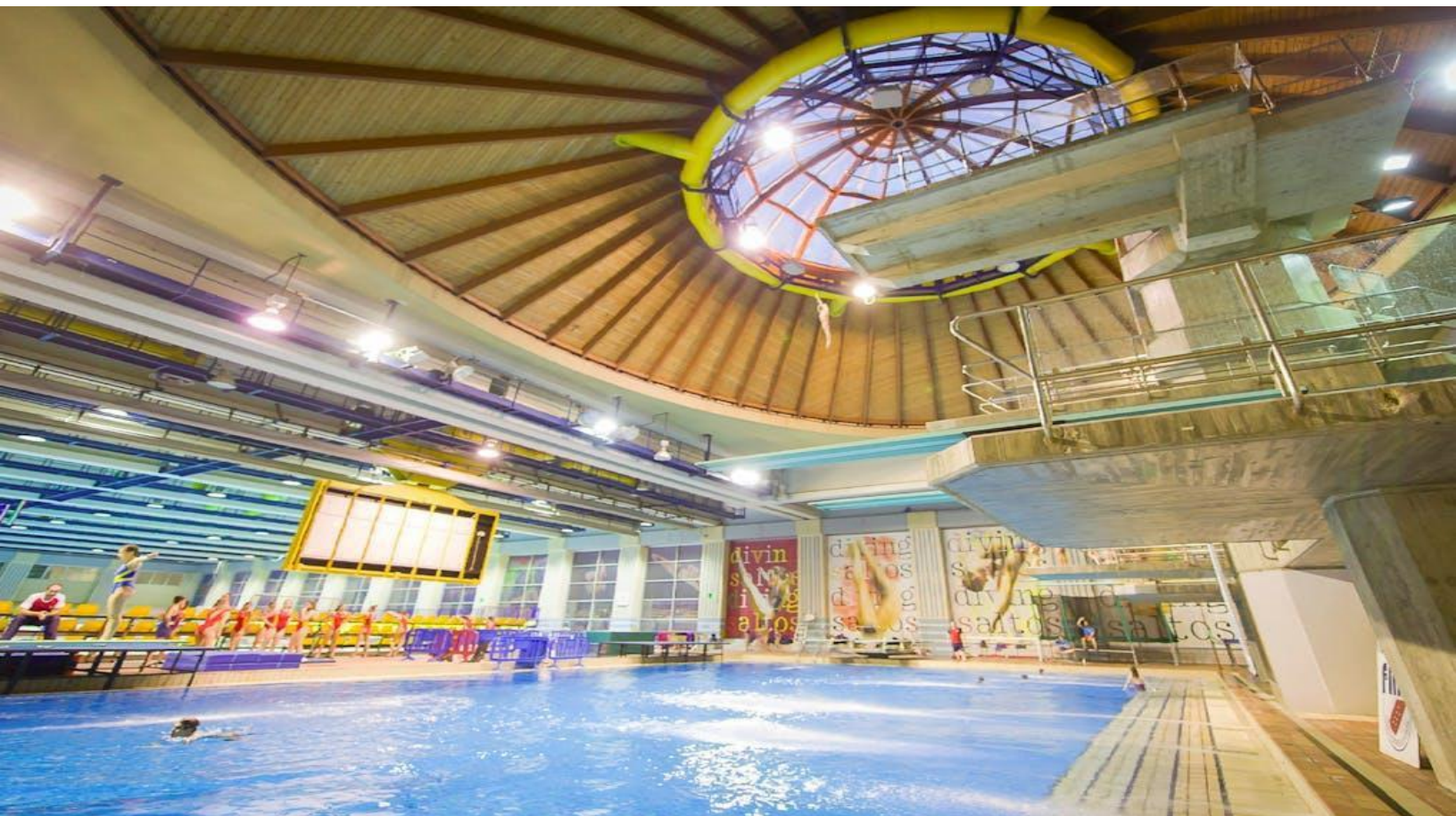

2 DIVING - RULES & FORMAT

The Madrid International Diving Meet 2023 will be conducted under AQUA diving rules.

FORMAT

Individual events will be run according to Preliminary, Semifinal (18 divers) and Final format (12 divers). The Synchronized diving event will be run as direct finals.

There is no limit on how many divers a National Federation can register but only the top 2 qualifiers of each country will progress to the semifinal. In the synchronized events only 1 team per country will be considered for the podium.

RULE REMINDERS

DIVELISTSUBMISSION

The statement of dives shall be submitted no later than 24 hours before the commencement of the preliminary phase of each event.

A secretariat office and dive sheet box will be available on the pool deck near the competition office.

In all events, the diver or the diver's representative may change the statement of dives before the commencement of the final, provided that the amended statement is lodged with the Referee, or their designated representative, no later than thirty (30) minutes after the end of the previous phase of the competition. If a new statement of dives is not submitted within the prescribed time, the diver shall perform the dives as indicated in the previous submission.

As the World Aquatics Rules, all diving sheets are to be submitted no later than 24 hours before the commencement of the preliminary competition in each event. The diving sheets will be handled through the Diverecorder program; you may have access through the web page (<http://www.diverecorder.co.uk/online sheets/index.php>) and download the program for filling the diving sheets.

4 ARRIVAL & TRANSPORTATION

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

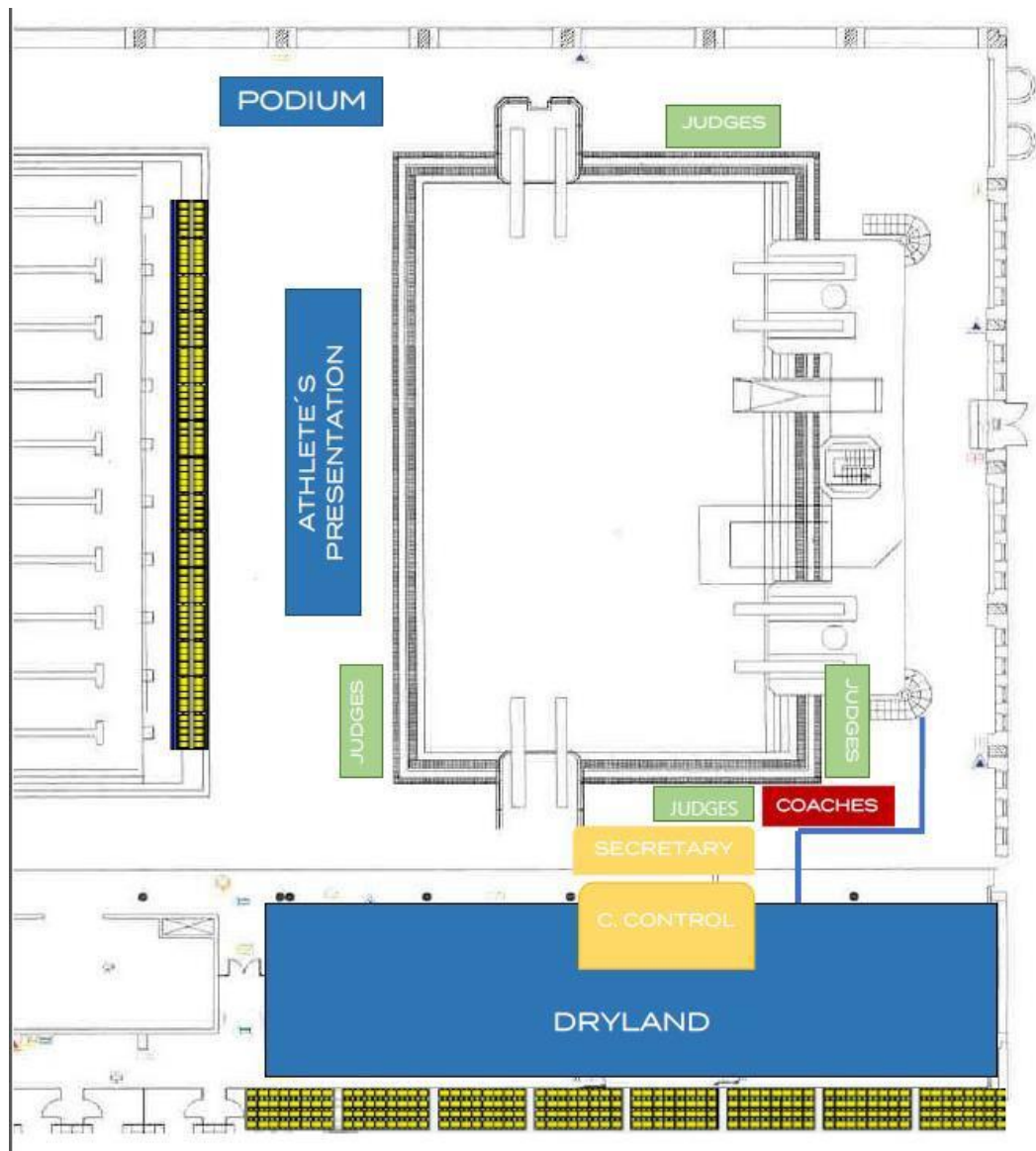

6 COMPETITION VENUE

Only divers competing at each session and their coaches will be allowed in the field of play. A dedicated coaching area will be provided.

Divers and team officials not competing on the session may remain on pool deck in the designated seating areas, in the dry-land training area or in the designated zones outside of the pool deck.

The best seating area for your athletes when not competing and/or training is located either in the stands or in the designated bleachers installed on the pool deck. To ensure a smooth development of the competition meet, we would appreciate to consider this recommendation.



The facility has:

- 4 Springboards 1 m.
- 4 Springboards 3 m.
- 1 Platform 5 m.
- 1 Platform 7'5 m.
- 1 Platform 10 m.

Dryland:

- Trampoline
- Weight area
- Air track
- Mats

7 JUDGES

A Federation taking part in MIDM '23 with a team of four (4) divers or more should bring a judge A or G category from AQUA list. The judge might, however, also serve as coach provided that does not concern the event he/she is judging.

8 MEDICAL SERVICES

ON-SITE MEDICAL SERVICES

There will be a doctor at the pool to look after possible injuries.

In case of needing hospital assistance, all participants must have medical insurance provided by their National Federation. The LOC will coordinate with the Team Delegate the transfer to the Hospital.

LIFEGUARDS & EMS SERVICES

Lifeguards will be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition to provide first aid. They are responsible to respond to all emergencies in coordination with the meet Doctor.
